St John's Seminary Wonersh – Can you help our future priests? The Seminary, near Guildford, Surrey, has been involved in the formation of priests for over 125 years. It is looking for help with the cost of refurbishment of 30 of its bedrooms, which have received little or no upgrading for nearly 50 years. Many rooms have threadbare or no carpets, and curtains close to disintegration. Some of the beds and other furniture came from the Junior Seminary at Mark Cross, Sussex – which closed in 1970. The Seminary operates on a very tight budget, and there are no funds available for this much needed work, which would cost in the region of £2,000 per room.
