It needs help with the cost of refurbishment of 30 of its bedrooms, which have received little upgrading for nearly 50 years. Many rooms have threadbare or no carpets & curtains close to disintegration. Some of the beds and furniture came from the Junior Seminary at Mark Cross – which closed in 1970. The Seminary operates on a very tight budget, and there are no funds available for this work, which will cost in the region of £2,000 per room.
